The meeting will be held on **Monday, August 19, 2024, at 7:00 p.m.**

The subject of the meeting will be to consider and take such actions as the Board may deem appropriate in connection with the following:

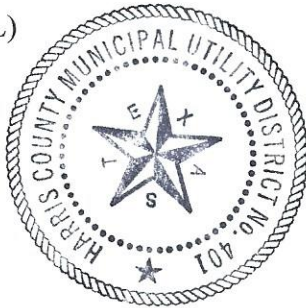
1. Consider report from Harris County Constable relative to security services for the District, and other security related matters, including review and approval of Interlocal Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the District and Harris County;
2. Comments from the public (the Board imposes a three-minute speaking limit for each member of the public wishing to address the Board, and public comments will be closed after this item);
3. Review and approval of the minutes of the meeting of the Board of Directors held on July 15, 2024;
4. Bookkeeper's report, including financial and investment reports, investment analysis, report on utilities expense, and authorizing payment of invoices presented;
5. Tax Assessor-Collector's report, including authorizing payment of invoices presented and approve moving accounts to uncollectible roll;
6. Champions Hydro-Lawn, Inc. report on facility site maintenance;
7. Engineer's report, including:
  - a) Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of contracts for the construction of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities and/or park and recreation facilities within the District;
    - 1) Review of bids and award construction contract for Inverness Estates detention pond outfall pipelining project;
  - b) Status of construction of water, sewer and drainage facilities to serve land within the District, including approval of any change orders, and acceptance by Harris County of streets for maintenance;
  - c) Consider potential development of Hooks Tract;
  - d) Consider review and approval of Capital Improvements Plan;

  - f) Consider status of park and facility maintenance;
