NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a public meeting at Staybridge Suites, 10011 Farm to Market Road 2920, Tomball, Harris County, Texas, said address being an office and meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Monday, June 15, 2026, at 7:00 p.m.

The subject of the meeting will be to consider and take such actions as the Board may deem appropriate in connection with the following:

1. Consider report from Harris County Constable relative to security services for the District, and other security related matters;
2. Comments from the public (the Board imposes a three-minute speaking limit for each member of the public wishing to address the Board, and public comments will be closed after this item);
3. Review and approval of the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Directors held on May 18, 2026 and May 22, 2026;
4. Bookkeeper's report, including financial and investment reports, investment analysis, report on utilities expense, and authorizing payment of invoices presented;
5. Tax Assessor-Collector's report, including authorizing payment of invoices presented and approval to move accounts to uncollectible roll;
6. Review of delinquent tax collection attorney report and taking appropriate action in connection therewith;
7. Consider authorizing the Delinquent Tax Collections Attorney to pursue the collection of delinquent taxes for 2025 and prior years, including the filing of lawsuits regarding same, as necessary;
8. Champions Hydro-Lawn, Inc. report on facility site maintenance;
9. Consider status of park and facility maintenance and ongoing park projects;
10. Consider approval of Amended and Restated Agreement with Champions Hydro-Lawn;
11. Engineer's report, including:
 - a) Authorizing the design, advertisement for bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of contracts for the construction of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities and/or park and recreation facilities within the District;
 - i. Review tank inspection reports and authorize preparation of plans and specifications relative to tank coatings;

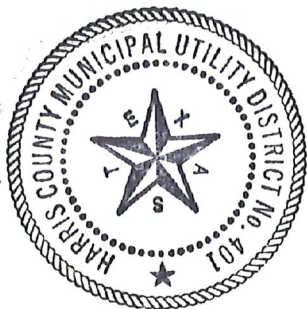
